SYMPTOMS

Symptoms of Sexually Transmitted Infections

Women:

- Abnormal vaginal discharge or bleeding
- Pain with urination, pain in the lower abdomen
- Pain with intercourse
- Genital itching or sores

Men:

- Discomfort or pain with urination or ejaculation
- Discharge from penis
- Genital sores

TESTING

When to Get Tested

- If you are experiencing any of the common symptoms
- If you have a new sexual partner
- If you're under 25 and having sex, get tested yearly.



INFECTION TYPES

Bacterial Infections:

Infections that can be cured with antibiotics & medications

- Chlamydia
- Gonorrhea
- Syphilis

Viral Infections:

Infections that are treated with medication to control symptoms & reduce transmission

- Genital Warts
- Genital Herpes
- HIV / AIDS

Other Infections

Infections caused by parasites and treated with antibiotics & medications

- Trichomoniasis
- Pubic Lice
